


## **Grades**

## Class organisation issues

- Class timetable is organised in **Individual courses**.
- **Friday** often free (for studying .... ) but some fieldtrips will be organised
- •Study material as well as list of readings is provided through the **Moodle website (Single sign on** is required, **each student receive an individual SSO** after her/his inscription)
- however you are strongly encouraged to integrate those materials with your own notes (taken during lessons)
- Although in Italy lecture attendance is not compulsory, you as ItF&W students are expected to attend all classes – Why?

## Class organisation issues (cont.)

- Because ItF&W is based on active class participation (in some cases participation even contributes to your final grade)
- What does "class participation" means?
  - You will be asked to make comments, ask for clarifications and further insights, give examples of how the discussed topics relate to the specific context of your country...
  - work in pairs, in group during class hours, prepare presentation, open a discussion ...

## Preparing for exams

Exams may take different forms: written essays, class presentations, projects ..

... and ORAL exams

#### How to prepare for an exam?

- Study carefully ALL the topics that the teacher has your notes and the readings provided by the teacher must be used to integrate the teaching material
- 2. Make sure that you have grasped the underlying **main** concepts and ideas behind each topic and that you can present them in writing and orally in a structured way

## Preparing for exams (cont.)

- 3. Check your preparation by **repeating** aloud the different topics, presenting the topics starting from a different perspective, by **connecting** different topics, by **relating** them to situations you are already familiar with (when provided by the teacher, a check-list is very useful for this purpose)
- 4. Whenever possible, study with a classmate or in group
- 5. Remember that, when you sit an **oral** exam, the teacher will pose a question about a topic expecting that you can present/discuss the topic for **at least some minutes**

## Exams inscription and grading system

- Formal inscription at each exam is required through
   UNIWEB platform, SSO is required. The exams scheduling
   is already available on the School website. However
   some dates may change. UNIWEB is the official source of
   information.
- All over Italy, our exam grading system is expressed in thirtieths (x/30)
- It is based on a continuous scale from 18/30 (pass) to 30/30 (excellent) up to 30/30 e lode ('with honours')

## Accepting or rejecting an exam grade

- IF YOU FAIL AN EXAM, you will be asked to repeat it until you pass
- If you are not satisfied with a grade that you received in an exam (you think you might improve it by studying more) you are allowed to reject a grade and re-sit the exam:
  - This should be an exceptional strategy, not a a regular behaviour ..... be careful not to challenge too much the endurance of the teacher
  - Consider the risk: once you reject a grade, this is 'lost' forever you might perform worse the next time ....



## **Graduation** (II year students)

- 30 ECTS
- 1 supervisor (among the teaching staff of the School) +
   1 or even more co-supervisors
- Thesis oral defense with a Committee of at least five UniPD academics
- 4 opportunities for graduation: sessions in June, July, September, October

## The language issue

- .... This is also reason why we insist so much on your proficiency on the language...
- •... do not count on 'I will improve my English just by attending the lectures and listen to the teacher ....
- You must also work on your general language skills (listening, writing, speaking)
- ... remember that students are either mother-tongue or requested to provide a high-standard language certificate
